

Production Workshop Operator (Yeadon)

Working within a safe, well organised, and clean environment you will help to build electronic housings, components and encapsulate products by following manufacturing and assembly procedures.

Additionally, you will ensure the smooth running of the Production Workshop room to maximise efficiency and meet the demands of the Production schedule

Key responsibilities and accountabilities:

1. Completing assemblies by drilling, fitting, and adjusting parts

- a) It is vital that the work you produce is of the highest quality.
- b) Work towards departmental objectives for a more efficient and productive function
- c) Completing sub-assembly metal and plastic housings and enclosures using hand and mechanical tooling.
- d) Experience or general workshop tools is required but full training will be given for this new role to help the successful candidate build on their manufacturing skills.
- e) Applying potting/bonding materials to encapsulate PCB's.
- f) Strive to keep a clean and organised 'Lean' department and take part in continuous improvements projects to better the workshop cell.

2. Lead by example and prioritise workload based on resources available with a view to being ahead of the Production Plan and aid the building up of completed products into stock.

- a) Be a positive individual that promotes teamwork and encourage ideas that contribute to improved quality, performance, and wellbeing of all Production Operatives.
- b) Have the vision to identify material shortages and equipment needs to keep the department running as efficiently as possible.

3. Maintain a safe, secure, and clean working environment

- a) Follow standards & procedures to produce quality products and sub-assemblies.
- b) Adhere to company Health & Safety policy and procedures, assist with reviews & execute improvements.

4. Support all other production line operatives as required

a) Learn and understand aspects of all production areas so that your skills can be used throughout the production business.

The above tasks are the key aspects of the role but, like any other role, it is not possible to specify every single task and requirement of the role and you are required to carry out any reasonable task required of you.
